About the Rescue

HHGDR has operated as a volunteer-run Rescue since 1992. It became a registered 501(c)3 nonprofit in 1998, and to date has placed more than 1,560 dogs in carefully screened forever homes. HHGDR serves Ohio, extreme northern Kentucky, and parts of

eastern Indiana.

Currently 16 dogs are available for adoption. In addition, the Rescue houses Sanctuary Dogs living out their lives in the safe environment of the Rescue (the latter unadoptable for health, age, or other conditions).

In 2016, HHGDR spent more than \$52,000 on vet bills alone. Contributions are always welcome and are tax-deductible.


